Our Back-to-School Schedule is outlined below.

August 28 Meet the Teacher Grades 6 - 12
Pathways to Success

September 3 Meet the Teacher PreSchool - Grade 5

First Day of School Grade 6 and Grade 9 only

September 4 Meet the Teacher PreSchool - Grade 5

First Day of School Grades 7-8 and Grades 10-12

September 5 First Day of School PreSchool - Grade 5

½ of Kindergarten - Maroon Group

September 6 First Day of School ½ of Kindergarten - Gold Group

Students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 will receive one breakfast and one lunch at no cost again this year. Students who choose to purchase an additional entree and/or a second lunch must have funds available in their account to do so.

Families are asked to complete an application for Educational Benefits. If families qualify, they will be eligible for discounts on Technology Fees, Activity Fees, etc. Additionally, for every family that qualifies, the District will receive funding that is directly used to provide increased academic support for children in all of our schools. If you would like help in filling out the application, please contact the counselor or social worker at your child's school.

Through the generosity of The Tiger Charge and United Way of Olmsted County, we have school supplies and backpacks available for those students who are in need.
