## **COMPUTER PROTECTION PLAN-Grades 9-12**

The Winner School District recognizes that with the implementation of the 1:1 computer initiative there is a need to protect the investment by both the District and the Student/Parent. For students in grades 9-12 who will be taking their computers home, the following outlines the various areas of protection: warranty, accidental damage protection and insurance.

VENDOR WARRANTY: The vendor warrants the computer from defects in materials and workmanship. This limited warranty covers normal use, mechanical breakdown or faulty construction and will provide replacement parts necessary to repair the computer or computer replacement. **The vendor warranty does not warrant against damage caused by misuse, abuse, accidents or computer viruses.** 

ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE PROTECTION: This coverage does not provide for damage caused by fire, theft, loss, misuse, intentional or frequent damage or cosmetic damage. Students may be assessed a fee for damages to their assigned computer using the fee scale on their computer checkout sheet.

INSURANCE FOR THEFT, LOSS OR FIRE: Computers that are stolen, lost or damaged by fire are not covered by the vendor Warranty or the Accidental Damage Protection outlined above. The following are the options that are available for these types of losses, and the Student/Parent must commit to one by checking the appropriate box.

This annual coverage begins upon receipt of the payment and ends at the conclusion of each school year. This covers total loss only and will NOT cover loss outlined in #15 of the Student Pledge.

## STUDENT PLEDGE FOR COMPUTER/iPAD USE-All students

- 1. I will take good care of my device and understand that I will be issued the same device each year.
- 2. I will never leave my device unattended.
- 3. I will never loan my device to other individuals.
- 4. I will know where my device is at all times.
- 5. I will charge my device's battery daily. There is no guarantee that a charger will be available to borrow.
- 6. I will keep food and beverages away from my device since they may cause damage to the device.
- 7. I will not disassemble any part of my device or attempt any repairs.
- 8. I will protect my device by only carrying it while in the bag provided the WHS approved case. Other items will not be placed in the case as they may cause damage to the device and result in probationary status.

If my device is in a classroom cart, I will carry it carefully when needed and place it in the cart when not in use. I will report any issues to my teacher.

- 9. I will use my device in ways that are appropriate and educational.
- 10. I will **NOT** place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the device or device bag.
- 11. I understand that my device is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of the Winner School District.
- 12. I will follow the policies outlined in the Student Handbook, Acceptable Use Policy, and the K-12 data center policies while at school or at home at all times of the day while using this "school-owned" device.
- 13. I will file a police report in case of theft, vandalism, and other acts covered by insurance.
- 14. I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse.
- 15. I agree to pay for the replacement of my damaged screen (\$50), bag (\$25), power cord (\$30), battery (\$100), top/bottom cases (\$25 each), keyboard (\$25) and other device components in the event any of these items are lost, stolen or damaged.
- 16. I agree to return all issued equipment complete and in good working condition.
