Description:

This \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a senior at Winner High School who has demonstrated an interest in and dedication to music.

Application Deadline:

Due to Val Ewing in the counselor's office by 3/7/24

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must reside in the Winner School District
2. Must have been actively involved in the music department in the Winner School District for at least 2 years of High School
3. Have demonstrated academic achievement, a minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
4. Must write a 500-word or less essay stating how music has affected his/her life and his/her biggest music accomplishment.

Selection:

1. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of merit and application content. Neatness, grammar, spelling, and completion of the application in its entirety will be considered.
2. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the committee by May 15, 2023.
