OFFICIAL SCHOOL BOARD POLICY**



HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Home or hospital instruction (homebound) is determined by the Winner School District when:

Any child with a health and/or physical impairment which, in the opinion of a licensed physician, will cause him/her to be absent from school for more than two (2) consecutive weeks and who school personnel determine can educationally benefit from such a program; or,

Any child whose educational needs, as determined by a case study and reviewed in a Teacher Assistance Team (TAT) conference, are most appropriately and effectively met by such a program.

The amount of instructional and/or supportive service provided through the homebound program shall be determined with respect to each child's educational needs and his/her physical and mental health.
