CITIZENSHIP: MORAL INSTRUCTION

The Winner Board of Education believes it has a significant responsibility to help students understand, appreciate, and feel a desire to perpetuate our American heritage, customs, traditions, and ideals. Therefore the school board instructs that students be taught the history and Constitution of South Dakota and the general principles of free government so they can comprehend the rights, duties, and dignity of American citizenship. Students will also be instructed on the proper manner to honor, respect, and display the flag of the United States.

Within the citizenship program the ideals of truthfulness, tolerance, sexual abstinence, public spirit, patriotism, respect for ethnic and minority groups, and, obedience to one's parents will all be highlighted. (SDCL 13-33-6)
