OFFICIAL SCHOOL BOARD POLICY**



GRADING REQUIREMENTS/GRADING PERIODS

The Winner Board of Education believes that instructional staff has the authority (with approval by their building principal) to develop class grading requirements. The Board of Education further believes that these grading requirements must be transmitted to each student; and, be generally outlined within each school building's handbook.

Grading periods are designated by the school district's annual calendar. Each administrator, teacher, student, and student's family is provided with this calendar at the outset of each school year. Grading periods are clearly outlined by dates highlighting the first, second, third, and fourth quarters of the school year. The only adjustment made to a given grading period would be due to a school cancellation (usually in the form of inclement weather or contagious disease). Finally, the school's annual calendar also outlines the ending date for the first and second semesters.
