

**WINNER SCHOOL DISTRICT 59-2
OFFICIAL SCHOOL BOARD POLICY**



COMPUTER LITERACY CURRICULUM

All students within the Winner School District 59-2 will have an opportunity to develop computer awareness, to become computer literate in a "hands-on" environment. Further, they will become computer fluent within a computer and technologically oriented society. Students will be provided the opportunity to study and learn about microcomputers and their applications and implications to the world around them. They will develop the skills necessary to communicate with microcomputers and recognize the microcomputer's capabilities, limitations and career options.

On June 21, 1993 the Winner Board of Education directed the Superintendent of Schools to develop a K-12 Technology Education Plan for possible implementation during the 1994-95 academic year.

This policy, in its present form (except for the Technology Education Plan) was originally adopted on 5-14-84. The amendment for the Technology Education plan was passed on 7-12-93.
