Title: Teacher's Aide

QUALIFICATIONS: High School Diploma

District Preference: Minimum of 48 Undergraduate Credits

REPORTS TO: Building Principal

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Administers, scores and records such achievement and diagnostic tests as the teacher recommends for individual pupils.
- 2. Works with individual students or small groups of students to reinforce learning of material or skills initially introduced by teacher.
- 3. Assists the teacher in devising special strategies for reinforcing material or skills based upon a sympathetic understanding of individual students, their needs, interests, and abilities.
- 4. Operates and cares for equipment utilized in the classroom for instructional purposes. May be required to lift stacks of paper, or move office equipment on a limited basis -- certainly no more than 25 pounds at any one time.
- 5. Helps pupils master equipment and/or instructional materials assigned by one or more classroom teachers.
- 6. Distributes and collects workbooks, papers, and other materials for instruction.
- 7. Guides independent study, enrichment work, and remedial work set up and assigned by the teacher.
- 8. Assists with the supervision of students during emergency drills, assemblies, play periods, and field trips. Also assists with playground duty. Because of requirement #8 this individual should be in good health as well as willing to be an active participant in many separate endeavors, that occur on a daily basis.
- 9. Keeps bulletin board and other classroom learning displays up to date.
- 10. Assists with such large group activities as drill work, reading aloud, and story telling.
- 11. Reads to pupils, listens to students read, and participates in other forms of oral communications with students.
- 12. Assists students in the library and/or media center.
- 13. Checks notebooks, corrects papers, and supervises testing and makeup work, as assigned by the teacher.
- 14. Checks and records pupil attendance.
- 15. Alerts the regular teacher to any problem or special information about an individual student.
- 16. Submit to health screening and comply with all school district policies.
