## MIDDLE SCHOOL/HIGH SCHOOL TRANSITION

Should a middle school youngster (grades 7-8 only) demonstrate the ability to participate at the junior varsity/varsity level, the building principals, coach, parent (and student) will meet to confer on the following topics:

- 1. The middle school student will very likely be the victim of some jealousy among his/her peer group. S/he must realize that they may have some trouble with acceptance among students their own age.
- 2. The middle school student must realize that some high school students may object to his/her placement in an upper level sport/activity.
- 3. The middle school student must realize that s/he will be traveling with older youngsters and, as such, may feel a degree of uncomfortably:

The decision about whether to move to an upper level sport/ activity will be left to the parents and their son/daughter. They will be given time to think over the advantages and disadvantages. This decision does not have to be made at the initial meeting.
