WINNER SCHOOL DISTRICT HALL OF FAME

Purpose:

To establish a method of recognizing and honoring Winner School District graduates, former staff members and community members who have distinguished themselves by their individual/team contributions in any of the following categories:

- Academic/Scholarship accomplishments
- Athletic accomplishments
- Fine Arts accomplishments
- Career/Professional accomplishments
- Community Service

Selection Committee:

- A. The selection committee will be composed of ten members:
 - (1) Winner Board of Education Member
 - (1) Winner High School Activities Director
 - (1) Winner High School former or present principal
 - (2) Winner High School former or present coaches representing both male and female
 - (2) Present or former persons representing the Winner High School Fine Arts programs
 - (3) Community members on a rotating three (3) year schedule
- B. The Winner School District Superintendent will make the initial selections to the selection committee and will decide on a replacement if there is a resignation or change in the selection committee.
- C. All selection committee members will have voting privilege.
- D. The selection committee shall elect a chairperson and a secretary.
- E. The Winner High School Activities Director shall serve as chairperson in the absence of the selected chairperson.
- F. All nominations shall be sent to the Winner School District Activities Director.
- G. The Winner School District will serve as the fiscal agent for the Winner School District Hall of Fame.

Selection Process:

All Winner School District graduates, former staff members and community members are eligible for selection into the Winner School District Hall of Fame.

Criteria for former students:

- must be a graduate of the Winner High School at least five (5) years prior to being selected prior to being selected.
- superior accomplishments by his/her scholastic achievements, athletic achievements and/or Fine Arts achievement while attending Winner High School.

- superior accomplishments after graduation by his/her post secondary scholastic achievement, athletic/Fine Arts achievements, career/professional achievement, military service and/or community service.
- must be of good character reflecting credit to the person, the school and society.

Criteria for former Winner School District staff:

- becomes eligible for selection five (5) years after leaving the Winner School District.
- must have evidence of an outstanding career at the Winner School District.
- must have had a direct and significant impact on school district scholastic, athletic and/or Fine Arts program.
- must be of good character reflecting credit to the person, the school and society.

Criteria for community member:

- may or may not be a graduate of the Winner School District
- must be a local citizen or business person
- must have made extraordinary contributions to the Winner School District resulting in significant benefit or exceptional honor to the school district.

Nomination Process:

Candidates may be nominated at any time during the year. The nomination form can be obtained from the school district administration office or from the Winner School District website at: www.winner.kl2.sd.us

Once a candidate is nominated, he or she will stay on file and will be considered each year.

Induction Process:

The selection committee will meet each September to select the inductees. Induction ceremonies will take place each September – February at a school event. The inductee will be honored with a brief overview of their achievements read over the public address system and a plaque will be present to the inductee. A plaque will also be placed in the National Guard Armory that honors all the Hall of Fame inductees. The inductees will be honored in the local paper as well as on the school district website.
