
The Winner School District "Four Day Week Research Team" is honored to present this proposal to the Winner School District Board of Education for review and implementation in the 2011-2012 academic year.


Warrior P.R.I.D.E, our district mission statement, guides the development and implementation of educational initiatives encompassing the academic and co-curricular programs impacting student achievement.
