MARGARET NOVOTNY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Guidelines

- Margaret Novotny has established a trust account with the Winner School District for scholarship purposes. The interest accrued each year from this account will be awarded as a scholarship to a student chosen by the Selection Committee. In addition to the original account deposit there will be added monies received at the time of the death of Margaret Novotny. In the event the Selection Committee chooses not to award a scholarship for any academic year, the accrued interest will be added to the original principal.
- 2. The high school guidance office will make application forms available. Completed applications will be returned to the guidance office by April 15 of each year.
- 3. The Selection Committee will be composed of:
 - A.) A school representative selected by the high school counselor.
 - B.) A representative from the Parish selected by the Parish Council.
 - C.) A representative from the Catholic Daughters organization.

The Committee members will act independently of one another in making their selection. Completed application forms will be duplicated and given to each Selection Committee member following the April 15 deadline by the school counselor. Committee members will return the forms to the school counselor.

4. Selection (or non-selection) will be made by totaling the points of the Selection Committee. The following point system will be utilized in determining the scholarship awardee.

Academic Achievement	20 points
School Activities	20 points
Parish Involvement	35 points
Community Involvement	15 points
Family Responsibilities	10 points
	100 points total

In order for a student to be awarded the scholarship they must have the highest point total from the judges. That cumulative total must be no lower than 220 points from 3 judges. If no student receives a 220 point total than no scholarship is awarded for the year.

- 5. Announcement of the scholarship winner will be made first by way of the parish bulletin and followed by newspaper and radio announcements.
- 6. Presentation of a scholarship certificate will be made at the Senior Graduation Mass, the Senior Graduation Breakfast or in some other appropriate manner.
- 7. The scholarship check will be made out to the post high school institution of the student's choice. The check will have the name of the student on it.
