

South Dakota State 4-H Scholarship Application



Robert and Maxine Olson 4-H Endowment #101699

1 - \$1,500 Scholarship

- The recipient shall be enrolled at any accredited post high school educational institution. Both graduating high school seniors and current higher education students are eligible.
- The recipient must be in good standing during their 4-H membership and demonstrate participation in 4-H programming and leadership activities.
- The recipient shall demonstrate commitment to their academic pursuits and progress toward attaining their post high school degree and/or certification.
- Preference shall be given to residents of South Dakota pursuing education at South Dakota higher education institutions.
- The scholarship may be renewed at the discretion of the 4-H selection committee.

Folkerts Family Scholarship #101700

1 - \$1,200 Scholarship

- Selection criteria is based on: 40% Scholastic Achievement, 10% Character, 40% 4-H Project Involvement (Citizenship/Community Service/Leadership) and 10% Financial Need.
- · Recipients must have a minimum of five years of active membership in South Dakota 4-H to be eligible.
- Recipients must have been in good standing during their 4-H membership and demonstrate participation in leadership activities.
- Recipients shall demonstrate commitment to their academic pursuits and progress toward attaining their post high school degree and/or certification.
- Do not submit a 4-H Journal or 4-H Record Book as part of the application.
- Recipients shall be graduating high school seniors enrolled at SDSU. Scholarship may be renewable during their sophomore, junior, and senior year if they maintain a 2.8 GPA.
- Preference shall be given to residents of Davison County, South Dakota. If there are no eligible recipients from Davison County, the scholarship shall be open to any SDSU student with a background in 4-H.

John F. and Beryl Younger 4-H Scholarship #10722

1 - \$700 Scholarship

- Selection criteria is based on: 40% Scholastic Achievement, 10% Character, 40% 4-H Project Involvement (Citizenship/Community Service/Leadership) and 10% Financial Need.
- Recipients must have a minimum of five years of active membership in South Dakota 4-H to be eligible.
- Recipients must have been in good standing during their 4-H membership and demonstrate participation in leadership activities.
- Recipients shall demonstrate commitment to their academic pursuits and progress toward attaining their post high school degree and/or certification.
- Do not submit a 4-H Journal or 4-H Record Book as part of the application.
- Recipients shall be graduating high school seniors enrolled at SDSU or students currently attending SDSU to be eligible.
- The award shall be made to recipients pursing a degree in elementary or secondary education or family
 consumer sciences education within the Department of Teaching, Learning and Leadership or Agriculture Bio
 Science.

BOB HEALY MEMORIAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP #102145

1- \$2,000 Scholarship

- Selection criteria is based on the following: 40% scholastic achievement; 10% character; 40% 4-H project involvement including Citizenship/Community Service and Leadership; and 10% financial need.
- Recipients shall be enrolled at South Dakota State University in the College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences (CAFES). Both graduating high school seniors and current higher education students are eligible.
- Recipients must be in good standing during their 4-H membership and demonstrate participation in leadership activities.
- Recipients shall demonstrate commitment to their academic pursuits and progress toward attaining their post high school degree and/or certification.
- Recipient shall be a resident of South Dakota.
- Do not submit a 4-H Journal or 4-H Record Book as a part of the application.

Matz Family Scholarship #81392

1-\$2,000 Scholarship

- Selection criteria is based on: 40% Scholastic Achievement, 10% Character, 40% 4-H Project Involvement (Citizenship/Community Service/Leadership) and 10% Financial Need.
- Recipient must have a minimum of five years of active membership in South Dakota 4-H to be eligible.
- Recipient must have been in good standing during their 4-H membership and demonstrate participation in leadership activities.
- Recipient shall demonstrate commitment to their academic pursuits and progress toward attaining their post high school degree and/or certification.
- Do not submit a 4-H Journal or 4-H Record Book as part of the application.
- Recipient must be a graduate of a West River, South Dakota high school.
- The award will be made to a current student enrolled at SDSU and pursuing a degree in the College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences.
