Primary Responsibilities and Expectations:

The Varsity Baseball Head Coach is responsible for the overall development and management of the St. Joe's baseball program. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Coordinate, develop, and promote all baseball teams (FR, JV, VAR)
- Coach and mentor student-athletes while positively promoting the mission of St. Joe's and the athletic department
- Hire, supervise, and mentor coaching staff (FR, JV, VAR)
- Organize, in conjunction with the Vice President of Athletics, all aspects of the program, including budget, facility, game, practice, and operational duties
- Coordinate travel & logistics for all practices and games
- Work with the admissions office to identify quality student –athletes and participate in admissions functions
- Attend all MMHSAA meetings and required events
- Implement, monitor, and enforce all institution, league, and NYS rules associated with your sport
- Other duties as assigned

In addition, this position will be expected to display a commitment to excellence on and off the field. The qualified candidate must possess effective communication, organizational and interpersonal skills as well as an enthusiasm to work closely with a diverse array of student-athletes and colleagues.

The Varsity Baseball Head Coach reports to the Vice President of Athletics and is a member of the Athletic Department. This is a part time, seasonal position. The salary, based on experience, ranges from \$5000 - \$6000. Additional income opportunities are available through camps and clinics.
