

High School and Middle School Athletic Participation Fee - updated July 2017

Why an athletic participation fee?

- The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education voted in May 2010 to include middle school athletics in the 2010-2011 budget reductions. Subsequently, the Board voted in June to approve an athletic participation fee for middle and high school student-athletes beginning in the 2010-2011 school year. Every middle and high school student-athlete pays a fee for each interscholastic sports season in which they participate on one or more teams.
- Funds from the participation fees, along with a \$1 surcharge from high school regular season ticket sales will help fund the middle school interscholastic athletics program, which in turn supports athletics at the secondary level.

Outlining the fee

- Parents should not pay a participation fee until after tryouts and the coach has placed the student on the team roster.
- Fee schedule:
 - a. High school students will pay \$125 for each sport season (fall, winter, spring) in which they participate on one or more teams.
 - b. Middle school students will pay \$75 for each sport season (fall, winter, spring) in which they participate on one or more teams.
- Students enrolled in a high school or middle school that does not field athletic teams will pay their participation fee at their home school.
- The participation fee does not guarantee playing time.
- The participation fee does not guarantee a full complement of contests.

How to pay the athletic participation fee

- Speak with the school Athletic Director for payment options at the school.
- Pay online using a credit card or debit card. A processing fee will be added by the contracted vendor. For additional information go to <u>www.CMSAthleticZone.com</u> and click on the athletic participation fee tab.

Refunds of participation fees

• Refunds will not be given if a student-athlete quits a team, is removed from a team, withdraws from the school, or is injured during a practice and/or contest and cannot play. Refunds in other circumstances beyond district control will be decided on a case by-case basis. *Exception: A student-athlete who pays the participation fee in a sport that is cancelled by the school prior to the first contest will receive a refund.*

Participation fee and/or waiver deadline

- A student-athlete who makes a team must pay the participation fee or meet waiver criteria prior to the first regular season game in their sport.
- A student-athlete who has not paid the fee or met waiver criteria by the first regular season game will be removed from participating in practices and contests.
- A student may rejoin their team once their participation fee is paid of waiver criteria met.

Outlining the waiver criteria

- Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools participates in the federal Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). CMS CEP & non-CEP schools have students who are directly certified for meal benefits because they live in households that participate in SNAP, TNAF, FDPIR or who qualify based on documented status.
- A family will receive a notification letter from CMS Child Nutrition if their child is directly certified for meal benefits. *ONLY directly certified student-athletes automatically qualify for a participation fee waiver.*
- A student who attends a CEP school but is not directly certified may, if they qualify, complete the Application for Need Based Assistance form *accompanied by* proof of total household income (pay stub, tax return, etc.). The Application for Need Based Assistance form serves in the place of the free and reduces lunch (FRL) letter.
- A student who attends a non-CEP school but is not directly certified may apply for free and reduced lunch status. A student at a non-CEP school who is approved for FRL will have their participation fee waived. A family will receive a notification letter from CMS Child Nutrition if their child is approved for free and reduced lunch.

Waiver process information

- Directly certified student-athletes must provide a copy of the letter from CMS Child Nutrition confirming their directly certified status.
- Students at CEP schools who are not directly certified must complete the waiver of athletic participation fee form <u>and</u> the Application for Need Based Assistance form accompanied by proof of total household income.
- Students at non-CEP schools who are not directly certified must complete the waiver of athletic participation fee form and provide a copy of the letter from CMS Child Nutrition confirming their FRL status.
- A separate waiver of athletic participation fee form and applicable letter from CMS Child Nutrition must be submitted for each student-athlete in the family.
