ROCHESTER BEACON ACADEMY- RBA POLICY No. 411 OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to define the parameters of permissible outside employment for RBA employees.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of RBA to ensure that employees do not begin employment or selfemployment that may constitute a conflict of interest.

III. OBTAINING CONSENT FOR OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT

- A. Before commencing self-employment or accepting employment with any other entity, an employee must obtain consent from his or her supervisor.
- B. Outside employment must not:
 - 1. Create any actual or potential conflict of interest;
 - 2. Interfere with the performance of the employee's responsibilities and duties; or
 - 3. Interfere with the employee's attendance requirements.
