Admissions Committee

Membership: The admissions committee shall consist of one board member, admissions director

and a minimum of three at-large members that can provide direction related to the

enrollment and admissions of the school.

Purpose: The purpose of the admissions committee is to:

 Review and monitor the ongoing enrollment of the school and efforts to maintain and increase enrollment at desired levels.

 Provide a mechanism to report to the Board of Directors on the status of the enrollment and efforts to sustain desired student levels.

 Insure that the school is reaching out to the local community to ensure community members are aware of the opportunity for a Catholic education provided by Bethlehem Academy.

Structure: The Admissions committee is accountable and reports to the Board of Directors. The

committee meets monthly.

Function: The functions of the committee are to:

· Recommend courses of action for sustaining and increasing enrollment.

· Prepare regular reports to the Board of Directors.

• Review, evaluate and recommend to the board needed improvements.

 Review and monitor implementation of the marketing and admissions portions of the strategic plan.
