

BY-LAW ARTICLE XXX
Skiing – Nordic
(Cross Country and Jumping)
Boys and Girls

Sect. 1: Cross Country Skiing shall be administered by the NHIAA Ski Committee via the Policy and Procedures Manual. In all other instances, competition shall be governed by the USSA. (CM 5.19)

Sect. 2: Eligibility for competition in the State Meet is limited to those schools, which are members of the NHIAA.

Sect. 3: Divisional Alignment

Nordic skiing shall be aligned into two (2) divisions based upon enrollments and petitions subject to the approval of the Classification Committee.

Sect. 4: The Skiing Policy and Procedures Manual will provide specific information on the conduct of ski meets during the regular season and the State Divisional Championships. (CM 11.16)

Sect. 5: At the State Divisional Championships schools and/or competitors may compete only in designated divisional competition.

Sect. 6: Awards

Divisional: Official NHIAA Division Championship and runner-up plaques in addition to 15 team medals shall be awarded to championship and runner-up teams in each division for boys and girls. The competition shall include classical and freestyle events. (CM 5.19)

Medal Awards: Official NHIAA medals shall be awarded to the top three (3) competitors (boys and girls) in each division in classical and freestyle.

Divisional Skimeister Awards: Individual skimeister medals shall be awarded to the top three (3) competitors for boys and girls based upon the two divisional alignments shown in Sect. 3 of this By-Law. (See Skiing Policy and Procedures for details on participation.) CM 1.21

Sect. 7: Jumping

Official NHIAA championship and runner up plaque shall be awarded to the championship and runner-up team.

Medal Awards: Official NHIAA medals will be awarded to the top three (3) competitors for boys and girls. There is no jumping skimeister award.

Sect. 8: Meet of Champions

The top twenty (20) competitors in classical and freestyle for boys and girls will advance to the Meet of Champions.

Medal Awards: Individual medals will be awarded to the top six (6) competitors in each event for boys and girls. (CM 12.20)
