Spikes	Only ¼ inch Pyramid spikes are permitted on the Blue Hills Track. Athletes breaking this rule will be disqualified from that event.	
Facility Information	Blue Hills' track is a six lane track with a six lane straightaway. There will be a concession stand as well as meet t-shirts available for sale. Cash only. Please follow the included map to help with drop off and bus parking. At no point should athletes, coaches, or spectators enter the school.	
High Jump	 There is one composite high jump area Starting Height: Boys 5'4" Girls 4'4" Height progression will be opening height, then up 2" There is no limit to the amount of total jumps an athlete may take in competition 	
Long Jump	 No runbacks are allowed. Athletes should come prepared with a mark There will be one long jump pit with a painted board. Boys and girls will use a 12' board The event will be run as finals with all athletes given four attempts 	
Triple Jump	 No runbacks are allowed. Athletes should come prepared with a mark There will be one triple jump pit with painted boards at 24', 28', 32', 36' The event will be run as finals with all athletes given four attempts 	
Shot Put	 There will be one shot put sector at the facility The event will be run as finals with all athletes given four attempts Schools must provide shot puts weighing 8 kg or 12 lb. and meeting NFHS specs. 	
Javelin	 There will be one javelin sector at the facility using a grass runway The event will be run as finals with all athletes given four attempts Schools must provide javelins weighing 600g or 800g and meeting NFHS specs. 	

Discus	 There will be one discus sector at the facility The event will be run as finals with all athletes given four attempts Schools must provide discus weighing 1 kg or 1.6 kg. and meeting NFHS specs.
Minimum Measurements	For all field events except high jump each athlete's first legal attempt will be measured. All attempts after the first legal attempt will only be measured if they meet the meet standard.
Order of Events	Field Events- 1:00 start time. Check in at the events. Javelin: girls followed by boys Discus: girls followed by boys Shot put: boys followed by girls Long jump: boys followed by girls Triple jump: girls followed by boys High jump: boys followed by girls Track Events- 1:00 start time. Check in on the infield. Boys followed by girls in each event. All events are finals based on time. 4x800 110/100m Hurdles 100m 1 Mile 4x100m 400m 400m Hurdles 800m 200m 2 Mile 4x400m
