McMillen earns third D6 crown

Cambria Heights' Eckenrode also captures title at 189

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Glendale's Brock McMillen has faced stiffer adversity in his young life, including battling a heart condition, but his third District 6 Class 2A Tournament title was certainly no walk in the park.

The two-time state champion had to battle through a nasty cut on his lip that forced three lengthy blood timeouts against Saint Joseph's Catholic Academy's Amonn Ohl in the 138-pound finals.

"I kind of bit my lip," McMillen said, "and my mouth kept filling up with blood throughout the match."

McMillen (13-0) also found it hard to solve the rock-solid defense of Ohl, who seemingly matched the Viking senior in funk rolls to stave off normally highly effective offensive shots.

But in the third period, losing 1-0, McMillen broke through by reversing Ohl to his

back for five points en route to an eventual 5-3 victory on Saturday afternoon at the Altoona Fieldhouse.

The win made McMillen the first three-time district champion in program history.

"I feel real good," McMillen said. "The kid I wrestled was real scrambling, and I like scrambling too. It was a battle. We were both in on shots and I felt overall like it was a good match. I wrestled well, but I just need to finish shots better."

The only other champion from the Mirror coverage area was Cambria Heights' Ian Eckenrode, who captured his first title with a 4-0 win over Huntingdon's returning district runner-up Myles Baney at 189 in a battle of 2020 state qualifiers.

Glendale's Zeke Dubler (152) and Suds Dubler (172), Penn Cambria freshman Trent Hoover (113) and Tyrone's Hunter Walk (120) finished second with losses in the finals.

Eleven area wrestlers qualified for the Southwest Regional Tournament, which is set for Saturday at IUP. Only the top three wrestlers at every weight class advanced to regionals.

Defending District 6 team champion Glendale finished in third place in the team standings with 171 points. Forest Hills won the team title by 16.5 points, 96.5-80, over Penns Valley. Sectional champs Tyrone and Central were sixth and eighth, respectively.

"I think we did all right," said Glendale coach Brian Storm, who matched Tyrone with four regional qualifiers. "You always like to have a couple matches back in the wrestlebacks, but it's a tough tournament."

Tyrone went 3-for-3 in the consolation finals, with Korry Walls (106), Reese Wood (145) and Tommy Hicks (189) placing third.

"I think we did really well as a team," Tyrone coach Terry Tate said. "The biggest thing is we had three in the third and fourth-place matches, and we went 3-for-3."

Central's Andrew McMonagle (160) and Glendale's Brock Smeal (285) also finished third.

Central had three wrestlers come up a win short with fourth-place finishes in Tyler Biesinger (106), Jaxon Matthews (120) and Ian Crouch (126).

Step by step

McMillen earns crown, advances

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INDIANA — Glendale's Brock McMillen got a Southwest Regional rematch with Burrell's Ian Oswalt on Saturday at IUP's Frey Arena at the Kovalchick Convention & Athletic Complex.

It appeared to be a little easier this year for McMillen, who had to go to overtime to beat Oswalt in the regional finals last season.

SW CLASS 2A

McMillen beat Oswalt, 5-2, to claim the 138-pound title. The Viking two-time state champion set a program record by earning his third regional title.

"I wouldn't say it's easier," McMillen said. "I'd just say I strategized a little more."

Tyrone's Hunter Walk ran into Bishop McCort's Mas on Gibson for the second

straight week in the 120-pound finals. Gibson, the top-ranked 120-pounder in the nation, earned a 25-9 technical fall in 4:35 — nearly 2 minutes longer than the district finals.

"I made some adjustments," Walk said. "I was in deep on a shot and couldn't finish. I thought I did a better job at wrestling a little higher at my pace and slowing his (pace) down a little bit."

Five total wrestlers out of the 11 regional qualifiers from the Mirror coverage area advanced to the inaugural West Super Regional Tournament on Saturday at IUP. Glendale's Suds Dubler (172) and Cambria Heights' Ian Eckenrode (189) finished third, while Central freshman Andrew McMonagle (160) placed fifth.

It's deja vu

Glendale's McMillen beats same foes in moving to states

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INDIANA — Glendale's Brock McMillen has wrestled Burrell's Ian Oswalt in the finals of the last two postseason tournaments and Saint Joseph's Amonn Ohl in the semifinals or the finals in two of the last three tournaments.

"It's like Groundhog Day," Glendale coach Brian Storm deadpanned Saturday afternoon after McMillen won the 136-pound title at the Western Class 2A Super Regional Tournament. "Every tournament is the same, it seems like."

McMillen beat both Ohl and Oswalt to win the title in the fourth of five steps toward winning his third state title. He hammered Ohl, 16-6, in the semifinals and earned a hard-fought 5-1 victory over Oswalt in the finals.

"I felt pretty good," McMillen said. "I got to my shots, but he (Oswalt) is

just so hard to score on. I tried to keep my attacks going. Overall, I won, so we're just moving on."

McMillen (19-0) will vie for his third state title in the IFAA Championships on Friday at Hershey's Giant Center.

Cambria Heights' senior 189-pounder Ian Eckenrode placed fourth and is the only other area wrestler from the Mirror's core schools to qualify for the IFAA Championships. Eckenrode qualified for Hershey in a jaw-dropping way, rallying and pinning Quaker Valley's Patrick Cutchember in 4:55.

"That's exciting," Heights co-head coach and Ian's grandfather Mike Eckenrode said. "He's non-stop. That's what pulled that match out and put him in states."

"I was glad to see him scoring points there," Storm said. "I think he should have had even more. They had some back points they didn't give him, but it all worked out."

"There's some momentum during a match," McMillen said. "As the match went on, I started wearing him down and got to my shots."

In the finals, McMillen took Oswalt down in the first period, but he was nearly suffered a defensive pin as he attempted to score back points. McMillen avoided the danger and was up 2-1 entering the third period.

The top four at every weight class advanced to the state tournament.

Tyrone's 120-pound senior Hunter Walk finished sixth and had a sad end to his career. He was knocked into the fifth-place bout with a 6-1 loss to Brookville's Owen Reinsel. And then the 2020 state sixth-placer, who wrestled in Hershey twice, injury defaulted to Tussey Mountain's Trevor Husick in 1:36 to finish sixth.

Walk (17-6) was taken to Penn Highlands Tyrone, where X-rays confirmed a fractured right elbow, Tyrone coach Terry Tate said. Walk will also be evaluated for a possible torn ligament today.

"It was definitely not the way that we had hoped or thought that this weekend would go," Tate said. "Getting hurt at the end was not really a thought in our minds. I don't think Hunter has even taken injury time in his career,

McMonagle (8-7) lost 3-1 to Burrell's A.J. Corrado and Reynolds' Jalen Wagner, 7-4. Dubler (13-5) dropped a 2-1 decision to Saegertown's Landon Caldwell and was pinned by McGuffey's Ethan Barr in 4:30.

McMillen pinned Philipsburg-Osceola's Austin Foster in 37 seconds in the quarterfinals before taking eventual third-placer Ohl down six times en route to the major decision. McMillen had to rally beat Ohl in the District finals while wrestling with a badly cut lip.

He escaped 27 seconds into the period, stayed in good position and waited for Oswalt to try a desperation move. Oswalt tried a cement mixer with 5 seconds left, but McMillen slipped through and got a takedown.

"Someone has to come at you with 30 seconds left," McMillen said. "I was able to scramble out of it. I'm moving on, so I'm happy."

Three cheers!

McMillen captures third state gold

Glendale senior beats Burrell's Oswalt, 1-0

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HERSHEY — Brock McMillen doesn't usually show a lot of emotion after his wins, but after he captured his third state title on Friday at Hershey's Giant Center, the Glendale senior celebrated.

He did when the final seconds ticked off the clock after a tight 1-0 win over Burrell's Ian Oswalt in the 138-pound finals of the PIAA Class 2A Championships in a rematch of last year's finals.

McMillen (22-0) pumped his fists and raised his arms toward family and the small crowd on both sides of the arena.

"It feels awesome," the Pitt recruit said after climbing down off of the medals stand. "Every year, you work toward this goal, and when it finally happens, it's just amazing."

"I was excited. There's a lot of pressure when you're wrestling. I won, and that's what I felt."

"I'm really happy for him," Glendale coach Brian Storm said. "He's a good person, a good student and a good wrestler. I think he deserved it."

The victory was the exclamation point on a career in which McMillen wrestled in four state finals and became only the eighth District 6 wrestler in history to claim three titles.

"That's awesome," McMillen said of making history. "I work so hard for this and dedicate a lot to my life. Now I'm just trying to show that every time I step on the mat."

McMillen lost 7-3 in the 113-

pound finals as a freshman to Mount Union's Josh Boozel, who handed the Viking all four of his losses, including the District 6 and Southwest Regional finals.

McMillen won his first state title as a sophomore at 126, reeling off three straight 3-2 decisions, including in the state finals against Bishop McDevitt's Chase Shields. He won his second with a 5-1 tiebreaker win over Oswalt at 132.

"I used to come here when I was in the fifth and sixth grade when I was wrestling in PJWs," McMillen said. "I looked at it then and said 'That could be me some day.' My freshman year, I didn't get it done. Three years after that, I prepared and trained just looking at that moment, and it all worked out in the end."

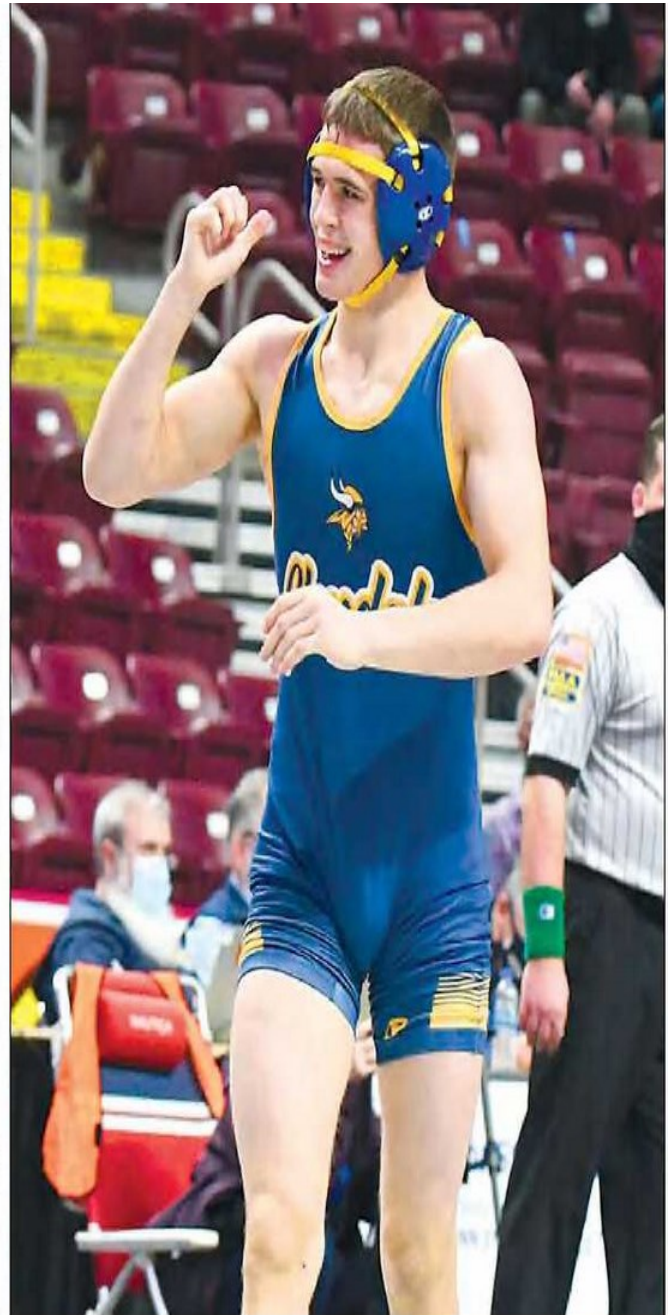
Cambria Heights' Ian Eckenrode finished out his career by placing seventh at 189 pounds.

McMillen reached the finals with a 16-0 technical fall over Lewisburg's Logan Barlett in the quarterfinals and a 9-4 win over St. Joseph's Catholic Academy's Anom Ohl in the semifinals.

It was again a familiar path to a title for McMillen, who outlasted Ohl, 5-3, in the district finals and in the Super Regional semifinals, 16-6. Ohl ended up placing third in Hershey.

"Ohl was very tough, too," McMillen said. "I knew our region would do very well. He's a great competitor, just like Ian. It was a lot of fun wrestling him also."

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While there was only one point scored in the finals, McMullen and Oswalt (24-3) found themselves rolling through a long flurry in the first period that produced no points.

"He's such a good competitor. He's tough to wrestle," McMullen said of Oswalt. "We were in a scramble for like the whole first period, where you didn't know who was going to come out. I practice that a lot, so I got through that and I knew I was going to have to find another way to win."

McMullen quickly escaped in the second period for the deciding point. Oswalt chose down for the third period looking for an escape to tie the bout. It never came.

McMullen used the crab ride effectively from the top position multiple times in the period to control and confound Oswalt. McMullen rode Oswalt out in the Viking senior's 150th career bout. McMullen raised his record to 143-8.

"I thought he controlled the match," Storm said. "It was just that the points weren't there. He did what he could do and rode him out. I didn't expect him to ride him out like that. I was nervous, but I don't think he was at all. He just knew what he was doing."

"Brock was ready for

that. He's been working on top a lot. Maybe that was what he had in his head."

McMullen jogged to his corner after his celebration and slapped hands with Storm.

"He's happy," Storm said, "and I'm so happy too for him. I hope he goes out and celebrates."

McMullen isn't done. The Vikings will be wrestling on Tuesday at Penns Valley in the semifinals of the District 6 Duals.

"I'll probably be back in practice tomorrow training," McMullen said.
