

Pino's Optimistic About Viking Team Because of Pitching Staff

FLINTON — In just four short years, Pat Pino has established a winning baseball tradition at Glendale Area High School.

And Pino, who is 37-22 over the past four years, thinks his fifth squad has a chance to do well.

"I think we should have a pretty good year," said Pino, who has five returning letterman back from last year's 8-6 team that was eliminated 2-0 by Bishop Carroll in the quarterfinal round of District 6 Class AA Playoffs. "But our infield is the question mark right now. We lost three games because of defense last year."

The Vikings, who open the season with a non-league game at Philipsburg-Osceola April 6 at 3 p.m., have two of the most experienced pitchers in the area returning this year.

Seniors Ron Jasper and Jeff Peacock, both letterwinners last year, are being counted on heavily by Pino to shoulder most of the pitching load. Pino is also counting on senior Dave Vereshack and junior Rick Holes to do some pitching.

Jasper, who completed seven of the eight games he started a year ago, was 4-3 with a 2.49 earned run average. He fanned 43 batters in 47 innings of work. Jasper also excelled on offense, finishing third on the team with a .413 batting average in 14 games.

Peacock pitched well, too. He chalked up a 3-1 victory record in 18½ innings of work. Peacock had a 3.12 ERA, and like Jasper, completed three of the four games that he

started.

"Pitching should be our strong point, especially with those two back," Pino said. "We really shouldn't have any problems with our pitching staff, that is, barring any injuries."

"I expect Jasper to pitch at least half of our games," he added. "And then the other three kids should pitch the rest of the games. Jasper is the most experienced of the four. He got a lot of strikeouts last year with his curve ball. He is sneaky fast, and that fools a lot of kids."

Pino's biggest problem might be getting someone to catch the four pitchers. Last year's starting backstop, Raul Delorme, who batted .415, has since moved to Hollidaysburg, and his departure has left Pino without an experienced catcher.

Pino, who stated that "I plan to flip-flop my catchers around the first few games until I find the right one," said he will alternate seniors Joe Cusick and Jim Peterson.

Besides Jasper and Peacock, other returning letterman include seniors Dave Vereshack and Randy Wills and junior Rick Holes. Vereshack batted .167 in 14 games last year. Wills hit .250 in 14 and Holes hit .143 in eight games.

"I think we're ready to go," Pino said. "I think the kids are set to play. We haven't been outside for about two weeks now because of the weather, but the times we have gotten outside, the kids have hit well."

Pino said he plans to use Jasper, who is lightning quick, as his lead-off hitter.

"He gets on base a lot and he puts the ball in play, so I'm going to use him in the lead-off spot," Pino noted. "I want him to get on base and get into scoring position for the other hitters."

Pino plans to start Cusick or Peterson behind the dish, senior Rich Strong at first base, Peacock or junior Jeff Noel at second, Vereshack or freshman Kevin Swauger at shortstop, and either Holes or Peacock at third, depending on whose pitching.

The three outfield positions are being contested by Jasper, who also could see action at first when he's not pitching. Vereshack, Peacock, Holes and senior Randy Wills.

The Vikings, 8-4 in the Moshannon Valley League last year, finished second to league champion West Branch. Even though he didn't come out and say it, Pino knows his team has a legitimate chance of winning the title this year.

"I expect three or four teams have a good chance to win the league this year," Pino responded. "And we should be all right."

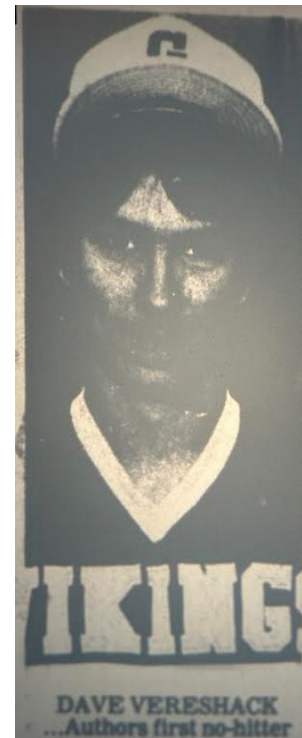

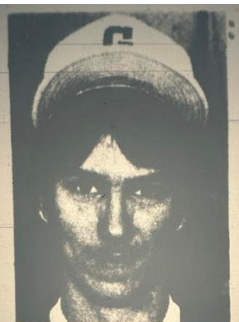
