

Early Games Crucial...

Inner Defense Is Vikettes' Forte

FLINTON — If the pitchers for the Glendale girls softball team can make the Vikettes' opponents hit ground balls, head coach Sherry Slaterbeck will be one happy woman at the end of the season.

If the pitching staff puts the ball in play to the infield, Glendale's defense should be involved in quite a few three-up, three-down innings, because the Vikettes' strength lies in their infield, a group that will be intact for the third straight year.

Dawn Greenaway at first base, Denise Jenkins at second, Melanie Ford at

third, Barb Noel at shortstop and catcher Diane Vincent won't have to spend any time getting acquainted during what passes for spring training in this neck of the woods.

"Pitching is the only area where we don't have a lot of experience coming back," Slaterbeck noted. "We lost Tammy Ford, who was our best pitcher last year.

"Pitching is the biggest factor, in my mind. But we do have a good number trying out for pitcher. If we only had one, then I'd really be worried.

"If the pitching goes well, then I think our whole team will go well."

Aside from the five returners in the infield, the only other letterwinner is outfielder Betsy Garman, who earned her monogram as a freshman last year.

"Shirley Snyder has played some outfield," Slaterbeck remarked, "and Wanda (Graboski) and Mindy (Peterson) have just moved into the area and show good potential. I'm not sure where Mindy will play, but she'll be in there somewhere."

Like most of the other area teams, Glendale has

not had much chance to practice outside, the weather being what it has been, but aside from the wind and rain, the Vikettes have to deal with a playing field that would have Revolutionary War general Francis Marion, the old Swamp Fox himself, feeling right at home.

"Last week, the field was under water," Slaterbeck reported. "I just hope we have some sunny, windy days so that it will dry out by our home opener (April 6 against Curwensville). It doesn't look like we'll get on it before then."

And what of the Vikettes' prospects in the Moshannon Valley League?

The coach thinks they'll do just fine, thank you.

But... "Our first four games are hard ones, and they were our downfall last year.

"We lost a couple of tough games by a run or two, and it took a good part of the season to get the girls up again.

"If we work well in the beginning of the year, we'll do all right. That's the key. If we get off to a good start, we'll be fine."

The Vikettes, who in the

past have played a strictly MVL schedule, have added a home-and-away series with Clearfield, opening their season Thursday at the Bison Athletic Complex.
