Defense Suspect, Hitting A Plus For Glendale Girls

FLINTON — For the last three years, Glendale High School girls softball coach Sherry Slaterbeck hasn't had to worry much about her infield.

Dawn Greenaway at first base, Denise Jenkins at second, Melanie Ford at third, Barb Noel at shortstop and Diane Vincent behind the plate started together for the past three seasons in the sun.

But this year, only Jenkins returns from that unit, which means that the Lady Vikings first line of defense will be somewhat suspect until it gets a few games under its belt.

Last year, Glendale finished the season at 6-7, 5-6 in the Moshannon Valley League.

This year, five letterwinners return — seniors Nancy Gallaher, Mindy Peterson, Paula Brungo and Jenkins and junior Betsy Garman, who has collected letters as a freshman and sophomore.

Jenkins will move from second to shortstop this year, with Gallaher slated for duty on the mound. Peterson behind the plate and Brungo and Garman in the outfield.

Filling out the infield positions will be seniors Lisa Troxell at first and Lisa Tiesi at third.

"The infield will consist of seniors, but it looks like they're working together," said Slaterbeck. "We have some injuries to overcome. Right now, I'm moving people around because of the injuries."

Slaterbeck expects her team to hit well this season, citing Peterson and Jenkins as the Lady Vikings' big sticks.

"The hitting should be fairly solid all around," Slaterbeck said. "I'm hoping that it will go well for us."

Handling the pitching chores will be Gallaher, who ended the 1982 season as the Lady Vikings' top hurler. Senior Carla Plessinger and sophomore Penny Ford will provide

help on the mound.

Battling for the third outfield spot will be sophomores Tammy Baum and Shirley Gates and freshman April Sanders.

"We have some promising ninth and 10th graders," Slaterbeck noted, "but the seniors will bear the brunt this year."

Glendale opens its season tomorrow, hosting Tyrone in a non-league affair.
