FLINTON — With four letterwinners returning from last year's 5-5 team, Glendale High School girls softball coach Sherry Slaterback is hoping that her fifth Lady Viking club can improve on that mark in 1984.

The returnees are seniors Betsy Garman and Brenda Rowles and juniors Tammy Baum and Mary Brungo.

When the Lady Vikings open their Moshannon Valley League season, tentatively Thursday against Moshannon Valley at Amesville, Slaterback will likely start sophomore Candace Peterson at first base, Rowles at second, Brungo or freshmen Karen
