Vikettes Drop Opener, Must Improve Hitting

FLINTON — With seven letterwinners returning all starters at one time or another last season, the Glendale Area High School girls softball team is hoping to improve on last year's 4-8 record.

But the Lady Vikings didn't get off to a very good start yesterday, as they dropped an 11-1 road decision to non-league foe Tyrone. The game was stopped after five innings because of the 10-run rule.

Glendale is also scheduled to play a non-league game this afternoon at Central Cambria.

"Our seven letterwinners are our key players," sixth-year Glendale coach Sherry Slaterbeck reported last night. "Our hitting is going to have to improve for us to be successful this year."

"Surprisingly, we didn't hit very well at all against Tyrone," she added. "We also made a lot of mental mistakes. We'll have to eliminate them, too. One thing good about yesterday's game is the fact that we played 19 players. It gave me a

chance to see what we have."

The seven letterwinners Slaterbeck's counting on are seniors Penny Ford, Mary Brungo and Tammy Baum, juniors Michelle Matthews, Candace Peterson and Deann Kuhn and sophomore Karen Noel.

Ford was the losing pitcher in yesterday's game, while Jennifer Burley picked up the win

for the Lady Eagles. No other details were reported.

Glendale will open its Moshannon Valley League season Tuesday at home against Mt. Valley.
