

1987 Season

FLINTON — Six letterwinners return to lead the Lady Vikings of Glendale in their quest for the spot of the Moshannon Valley Softball League this year.

The starting lineup is expected to be a solid one according to first-year coach Paul Conway.

"We have a good starting eight," said Conway. "We have two girls who are exceptional athletes and probably could play anywhere for anybody," said Conway referring to senior Karen Noel and sophomore Brenda Orrick.

Noel has started at the shortstop position for four years and is expected to be a leader at the position this season. Junior Mary Murray will split her time at second and first, although Conway she may see more time

at first this season. Sophomore Heather Irvin will battle for time at first and freshman Lisa Callihan will play second if Murray plays first.

In any combination, Conway is confident that the middle will be dependable. The battle for third base between senior Robin Conaway and junior Stacey Muse may result in the two sharing the time this year.

"I'd say our pitching is better than I first expected," Conway noted.

Senior Lorie Swasing will be the leader in the department with help from Noel and Senior Lori Hess.

Senior Pam Ivory will begin the season as the starting catcher for Glendale, a player, noted her skipper, who will "take charge" in directing the inside of

the diamond.

Orrick will start the opener in centerfield between either Tina Strong or Michele Feather at right and Kim Kephart at left.

"Kephart has an exceptional arm," said Conway of the senior. "She's going to give us a lot of experience there."

The trouble spot Conway will be the team's lack of depth. A bright spot for the Lady Vikes, according to the coach, is their bats.

"Hitting is going to be our strength," he commented, adding that Glendale is known for its power at the plate. Noel, Murray, Swasing and Orrick are expected to lead the category.

The batting lineup will most likely start with Swasing, Ivory and Irvin or Murray in the third slot. In the

middle will be Callihan, Noel and Muse or Conaway. Kephart and Orrick are expected to fill the seven and eight spaces, respectively with the ninth slot to be decided.

The Lady Vikes will try to beat the 1986 6-4 regular season finish as they begin the season April second at Cambria Heights in a non-league match.
