The Glendale High School softball squad will field a veteran team this year in a run for the Moshannon Valley League title. Four letterwinners lend a lot of experience to bolster the Lady Vikings' hopes of earning a winning season.

First-year coach John Lewis seemed positive about what the season may hold for Glendale. "I hope to be competitive and improve in the season. Other than that, I'm not going to make any predictions," Lewis said. "We played at Blacklick and they made young mistakes, but that'll improve as the season goes on."

Dual monogramwinners Mary Murray, a senior, and Brenda Orrick, a junior, will lead the team along with senior Stacey Muse and sophomore Lisa Callahan, both letterwinners, also.

The defense will feature sophomore Billi Jean Mansberger at first

and Murray at third. Orrick will be the starting shortstop and Callahan will take the second base bag.

The pitching chores fall on Muse and Heather Irvin, who was 4-1 as a sophomore. The backstop will be sophomore Sharlene Rupp with Melissa Johns and Dianne Misiura as back-up. Juniors Jill Jenkins and Becky Traveny, and sophomore Shannon Bloom will push for time in the infield.

In the outfield posts, junior Brenda Miller will see starting time in left with freshman Billi Jo Johns seeing time up the middle. Misiura, Paulette Potter and Angie Potutschnig will vie for time in left. Trish Gates and Shelly Mc-

Clellan will push for time, also.

Offensively Orrick returns to take over in the batter's box. She finished the 1987 season two hits behind Karen Noel, now a Glendale alumnus. Lewis added that Mansburg, Misiura, Gates and Murray may be able to dent opposing defenses.

"We'll have a nucleus back this year and we'll have to build around it," added Lewis. His assistant this season will be Linda Yanosky.

The Vikings play at West Branch today to open the Moshannon Valley League campaign in a 4:30 start.
