Lady Vikes Seek Second Straight MVL Title

FLINTON — Fresh off a 13-2 campaign in 1989 that included a Moshannon Valley League softball title, Glendale appears to be geared for another big season in 1990.

Seven letterwinners return for Coach Pat Pino's Lady Vikings this season, and Pino made it clear that he has high hopes for his team.

"We should be improved. We were 13-2 last season and we're looking better in some places," Pino commented.

"We have two main goals this season. We want to win the league again and we want to advance to the interdistrict playoffs. We lost in the semifinals of the District 6 playoffs last year."

Leading the way for Glendale will be sophomore pitching sensation Jen Wagner. Wagner pitched every inning for the Lady Vikes last season and figures to do so again this year.

"Jen threw every inning for us last year. She's capable of pitching at least a couple of times a week so I don't see any problem with her getting tired," Pino commented.

"She walks very few and gets the ball over the plate. Jen averaged about 10 or 11 strikeouts a game last season."

Wagner's batterymate will be either sophomore Nicole Smith or senior Sharleen Rupp.

The Lady Viking infield is solid and experienced around the horn. Senior Lisa Callahan will hold down the first base position with sophomore Sherri Frisco at

second, sophomore Roxanne Jasper at shortstop and senior Billi Jean Mansberger opening at third base.

Pino is confident about the job his infield can do.

"Our infield defense should be better than last year simply because with Jen pitching there aren't a whole lot of balls to play. Plus these girls gained experience last season," Pino said.

Rupp should also see action in left field while freshmen Jennifer Koteas and Connie Jasper will be in center and right respectively.

"We have just average arms in the outfield but we have really good speed to chase down balls," Pino said.

Offensively, Pino looks for a more potent attack from his lineup. In last Friday's opener, Glendale produced 16 runs in a

win against Conemaugh Valley.

Koteas will bat leadoff because, according to Pino, she is a good contact hitter and puts the ball in play. Koteas will be followed by Mansberger, a .300 hitter last season, Wagner, Smith and Callahan in the power portion of the lineup.

Rupp will bat sixth followed by Roxanne Jasper, Connie Jasper and Frisco.

"Our hitting should be improved this season. If it's any indica-

tion of things to come, we scored 16 runs and had 10 hits in five innings in our opener," Pino noted.

Glendale returns to action tonight when it hosts Clearfield at 4:00 p.m.

FLINTON—Jen Wagner hurled a no-hitter and the Glendale Lady Vikings shut out Harmony 10-0 in five innings in Friday afternoon softball action. Glendale remains undefeated at 6-0.

Viking Coach Pat Pino complimented Wagner's performance. "Jen had a good game, anytime you have a no-hitter it's a good game," said Pino.

This was Wagner's fourth career no-hitter. She pitched three no-hit games last season.

Pino also had kind words for

his offense. "We hit the ball well, we had 10 hits today. We also did a good job keeping the ball in play," said Pino.

The Lady Viking offensive got off to a slow start. Glendale was held scoreless in the first two innings but they made up for the lapse very quickly. The Lady Vikings scored nine runs in the third and fourth, and the game was stopped when they scored their tenth run in fifth.

Wagner No-Hits Mo Valley, Glendale Stays Unbeaten

AMESVILLE — A rested Jen Wagner made the Moshannon Valley girls' softball team her latest no-hit victim in a 16-0 Glendale victory on Wednesday.

Wagner, a sophomore who now has five career no-hitters, and her Glendale teammates hadn't played since April 24th, and with the eight days of rest the sophomore pitcher was ready to wail.

"She (Wagner) was well rested, that was the big thing," said Pat Pino, Glendale head coach. "Being rested she was real fast, strong, and had good control. They didn't hit anything out of the infield.

"Before the break we had six games in seven day. She got the rest and came back strong."

Wagner faced only 16 Black Damsel hitters in her five inning of work. She put 11 of the Mo Valley girls down on strikes, allowing just one walk.

In addition to doing the job from the pitcher's rubber, Wagner also got things going with her bat. Wagner had two hits in the game, one a triple, and three RBIs to pace the Lady Vikings.

Coach Pino was able to empty his bench during the contest as a

total of 21 Lady Vikes saw action in the game. Coach Al Pallo of Mo Valley was also able to get more than his share of players in action with 15 of the Damsels playing.

Glendale is now 9-0 on the season, and 6-0 in the Moshannon Valley League. Mo Valley is 0-6 both overall and in the MVL.

Next up for the Lady Vikings is an MVL contest at Harmony on Thursday, while Mo Valley will host West Branch Thursday.

Glendale Clinches Title On Wagner No-Hitter

DUBOIS—Jen Wagner pitched her third no-hitter of the season as Glendale clinched the Moshannon Valley League softball championship with a 4-0 win over DuBois Central Christian.

It was Glendale's second Mo Valley League title in a row.

Wagner faced the minimum number of batters, with only one hitter reaching base on an error—and later erased for leaving the base too soon. It was Wagner's sixth career no-hitter.

DCC's Sue McIntosh was almost as tough, allowing only Jen Koteas' seventh inning single. All four Glendale runs were unearned, due to the Lady Cardinals' four errors.

The Lady Vikes scored twice in the first frame on three DCC errors. Lisa Callahan reached first on a error, Billie Jean Mansberger did the same, and when Wagner made first on still another miscue, Glendale led 1-0. Mansberger scored next on a passed ball to boost the Lady Vikes' edge to 2-0.

An error put Sherri Frisco on first in the seventh, with a stolen

base and Jen Koteas' single—the only hit of the game—moving her to third. Another error with Callahan at bat let in Frisco with the final run.

"We were really hitting the ball well," said Glendale coach Pat Pino, "And they made some really nice plays in the field. We must have hit six or seven line drives—they were just catching them."

Glendale hosts DuBois Wednesday and finishes its regular season Friday at Clearfield.
