

Glendale's Outlook Not as Bright as Expected

FLINTON — A couple of weeks ago, before wrestling practice started, Glendale High School coach Blair Packer was anticipating a very different kind of year than he is now, just prior to the start of the 1984-85 season.

For one thing, senior Gary Rydholm, who went 18-8-2 last year at 167, did not turn out when the Vikings took to the mats.

Bill Miles, a senior transfer who lettered in the New Jersey schoolboy ranks last year, left the team, and two ninth graders who were expected to fill the 98-pound slot opted to compete on the junior high level.

The net result of these defections and other roster quirks is that the Vikings will be taking the mat with holes at 98, 119 and 126, and without Rydholm the Vikes will be trying to catch up without

the strongest (physically) wrestler on the squad. Not a situation likely to enable the Vikes to match their 11-5 dual meet record of a year ago.

"We'll be going into most matches down 18 points," acknowledged Packer, starting his sixth year at the helm. "We can't afford injuries."

"It will be a real challenge for us to hold our own against most teams, but we can't be concerned over what we can't control."

"Were we're strong, we're really strong. We'll put a really solid team out on the mat at the nine weights we have."

Heading the six returning lettermen will be junior heavyweight Jim Orichosky, who finished second in the District 6 Class AA meet and third at the Northwest Regionals last season on the way to a 30-6 record. That puts his career mark at 54-9.

Fellow junior Tom Ross placed second in districts at 155 last season, compiling a 27-7 record, after a 14-12-1 campaign as a freshman.

Craig Hamilton, a senior, went 15-15-1 at 126-132 last year, while Steve Potutchnig was 15-16 at 119-126.

Sophomore George Ginter earned an 8-13 mark at 105-112, while junior Chris Henry went 8-16 at 105.

Graduated from last year's squad is a trio of solid performers — Jim

Hamilton (21-9 at 132-145), Mike Ross (20-10-1 at 138-145) and Jerry Lasing (18-11 at 105-119).

"It appears as though it should be an exciting season, to say the least," Packer remarked.

The Vikings initiate the 1984-85 campaign tomorrow when they travel to Everett for the two-day, 10-team Tri-County Tournament.

Orichosky Ties Win Mark in Vikings' Victory

FLINTON — Heavyweight Jim Orichosky tied the Glendale High School record for career wins in capping the Vikings' 33-23 victory over Juniata Valley in a Tri-County League makeup match last night. The win was Glendale's fifth in a row and raised its record to 10-4. Orichosky's first-period fall over Jim Payne gives the talented junior a career record of 78-9, which ties him with

Brian McClellan (73-22) on the all-time win list. Orichosky is 19-0 on the season with 11 falls. As usual, coach Blair Packer's Vikings fell behind early, but came storming back in the upper weights to pull out the win. Glendale's Aaron Lewis pinned Brian Giles in 4:56 in the 98-pound bout to give the hosts a rare 6-0 start, but two forfeit wins, two major decisions and a regular

decision enabled the Green Hornets to rebound and take a 23-6 lead after six weight classes. Glendale, however, swept the final six bouts. Steve Potutschnig (138) notched a major decision, while Craig Hamilton (145) and John Peacock (155) won by regular decisions. Peacock's victory raised his record to 15-0. Chris Henry (167) posted a fall and then

once-beaten Tom Ross put the Vikes ahead with a 20-3 superior decision over Jim Shade at 185, improving his record to 19-1.

Glendale returns to its home mat tomorrow for a makeup match against Penn Cambria.

Vike Heavyweight Sets Career-Win Mark...

Orichosky Lifts Glendale Past Penn Cambria

FLINTON — Glendale High School heavyweight Jim Orichosky couldn't have picked a better time to etch his name in the Viking record book.

Orichosky manhandled Penn Cambria's Ron Mazur, racking up an 8-0 lead before pinning the Panther at 3:13 to notch career win No. 74 and lead the Vikings to a 29-28 squeaker over Penn Cambria last night in a Tri-County League makeup match.

The fall, the junior standout's 11th of the season, set his season mark at 20-0 and career log at 74-9, bumping 1981 alumnus Brian McClellan (73-22) from the top spot on Glendale's all-time win list.

"Jim's a leader and a winner," commented Viking mentor Blair Packer of Glendale's 1984 state qualifier. "He's extremely coachable and very personable."

Talented? "That goes without saying," Packer added.

The record-breaker paced the Vikings to their 11th come-from-behind win against four losses, while Penn Cambria fell to 3-7-1.

"I knew it would be a close match because they

have some tough kids, and they're really good at staying off their backs," said Packer, noting that Orichosky had the Vikings' lone pin.
