#### Proposal:

Consider approval of establishing criteria for the creation of a sixth classification for sports with 501 or more teams competing in the NYSPHSAA State Championships.

#### **Effective Start Date:**

09/01/2023

#### Rationale:

Currently several NYSPHSAA sports have more than 600 teams competing in the NYSPHSAA State Championships. In an effort to provide more equity amongst all NYSPHSAA Championship sports and greater opportunity for students to experience a NYSPHSAA Championship, criteria for a sixth classification is being proposed by the Classification Ad Hoc Committee.

With the proposed format by the Classification Ad Hoc Committee to establish classification cut off numbers of 75 (top) and 100 (bottom) a larger discrepancy exists for the number of teams competing for a NYSPHSAA Championship in the remaining classes when comparing five classes to six classes.

#### Process:

- Annual review and approval of school enrollment numbers and classification cut off numbers for non-variation sports.
- NYSPHSAA utilizing participation survey previous year and school enrollment numbers for the following year will generate a preliminary report to be reviewed by the Section Executive Directors.
  - o. Participating "teams" by sport will be used rather than the NYSPHSAA membership list.
    - Current merged "teams" will be counted as one team.
- Sections will report any reclassified non-public schools' current classification to NYSPHSAA.
  - o Non-public reclassified schools will be listed at the top of each classification.
- Sections will notify NYSPHSAA of ANY classification changes (mergers/ demergers, non-publics, new teams, etc.) following Executive Committee approval (October); <u>changes will not impact the</u> classification of another team.
- Variation sports will have the ability to utilize the criteria for establishing cut off numbers.

NYSPHSAA Staff
Proposal: The NYSPHSAA Staff and State Tennis Committees are seeking approval to mandate all high school tennis players to claim their profile in the UTR system prior to the season and also require schools to submit their match results within a timely manner. Sections may implement a procedure and reporting schedule that works best for them. Athletes with unclaimed profiles or incomplete match results at the end of the regular season will be ineligible for postseason competition.
Effective Start Date: Spring 2022
Rationale: Requiring schools to report results and players to claim their profile will allow NYSPHSAA and its tennis committees to utilize a complete database at the end of the season to properly seed the state tournaments. Eight sections are already using UTR with several of them requiring result reporting each season.
This mandate would mirror the same system used for wrestling which utilizes Track Wrestling to report rosters and results throughout the year so there is a complete and up-to-date system in place for postseason rankings. Wrestling also follows the same proposed penalty for noncompliance.

Our Lady of Lourdes High School (OLL) is hereby seeking admission to join Section IX Athletics for the 2022-2023 athletic season. The fundamental reasoning that is driving our desire to apply for membership is threefold: administrative, geography, and competitiveness.

Prior to my appointment as Athletic Director at OLL I had coached both Baseball and Boys Basketball at Millbrook High school for many years. I am very familiar with the philosophies and style of management of Section IX and I feel that this style aligns much better with the wants and needs of the athletic program at OLL that I am trying to instill. In addition, some of my current Coaches had previously coached in section IX and based on the input I received from them the manner in which Section IX handles the management of schools and scheduling is more appealing and less complicated than under Section I guidelines.

What can we do to alleviate transportation woes?

Possible solutions and Pros and Cons of each...

\*Move <u>some</u> high school games to Saturdays, and move majority of Modified sports to Saturday mornings.

#### Pros:

- More drivers are available for bussing.
- Parents may able to get to games.
- Officials may be more available.

#### Cons:

- Coaching contracts may preclude mandatory games on weekends.
- Would subtract a number of contests for Modified sports.
- Coaches may not be able to work weekend games due to many factors including:
  - Family functions
  - Personal responsibilities
  - o Coaches away all week from home, adding weekend to it could be an issue
- Players may not be able to accommodate weekend games due to:
  - Family functions
  - Club sports Forcing kids to play high school sports on weekends will force them to choose between club and school sports. This would not be a positive for school sports.
  - o Jobs many student athletes work on weekends
- Schools may not be able to accommodate weekend games due to:
  - o Game supervision not being available on a weekend
  - Not wanting to open the school on a weekend
  - o Custodial workers not being available on the weekend + overtime pay
  - Outside community groups using school facilities on weekends

#### \*Start games later and front load outdoor sport schedules.

#### Pros:

- More drivers are available for bussing.
- Parents may able to get to games.
- Officials may be more available.
- Indoor Sports would work out with later start times throughout season as would outdoor team sports with lighted fields

#### Cons:

- Late return during the week for student athletes
- Available Daylight during Fall and Early Spring will be an issue. Games may not finish.

#### \*Areas where we have been proactive already:

- We have adjusted modified volleyball matches so they no longer play on 14 dates. They play on 7 dates with two 3 out of 3 contests on each date. So they still play 14 games but have to travel half the time they normally would.
- Boys and Girls soccer are scheduled on separate days so there is no duplicate transportation.
- Boys and Girls basketball are scheduled on different days and sites are opposite of each other in case rescheduling needs to be done. They would be still opposite of each other on same date if rescheduled to the next day due to weather.
- We separate various levels of football so they are played on different days to help accommodate transportation and field congestion. Modified may play on Tuesday, Freshman on Wednesday, JV on Thursday and Varsity on Friday and Saturday.
