- b. Section IX Team Tennis
 - Chairpeople stress that there many hurdles to overcome to keep Team Tennis a viable opportunity for Section IX Schools. It makes the already short season even more condensed. The regular season is difficult as it is to complete to get clear team representation. Despite the drawbacks which could hinder the future of team tennis, both coordinators agree the experience for teams is a great one. A letter from Urvashi Gupta, Section IX Co-Coordinator, detailing the issues that plague team tennis was included in the materials for review. The MHAL voted to approve keeping team tennis going for Section IX to send representatives to NYSPHSAA Championships. *Motion to approve* keeping *Boys/Girls Team Tennis* going for Section IX *made by Mr*.
