Pass Gate Lists: AD's/Coaches need to submit pass gate lists via **email to** the tournament director **before 3:00pm on Thursday, February 8.**

- Passes: Four coaches, two managers, and one student video, photo, and newspaper representative (school authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge but their names must be on the pass gate list. Only WIAA authorized passes, WSCA (WA Coaches Association) passes and WSSAAA (WA athletic director association) passes will be honored. School district and league passes will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.
- Signage: No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

- Buses: After dropping off teams in the front of the high school, at the far south end as possible, they leave the parking lot, turn right and go to the round-a-bout and enter the student parking lot then turn left and park in the upper lot on the south end of the parking lot. - Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.
- Qualifiers: The top **FIVE (5)** wrestlers will advance to the WIAA Mat Classic XXXV at the Tacoma Dome on February 16-17, 2024. The sixth-place finisher will be the Region 3 alternate to state.
- Awards:Medals awarded to the top four placers in each weight class.All wresters will wear their school warm-ups on the podium.NO HATS, HOODS, OR HEAD PHONES ON THE PODIUM OR FOR WIAA STATE PROGRAM PHOTOSNo team awards
- Bracketing: There are three possible brackets with a randomly chosen rotation. Seeding criteria could change assigned bracket.
