## Weigh-ins

Coaches should arrive with a weight-in sheet printed for this event from Track Wrestling. Wrestlers will weigh in by weight class. All wrestlers must present picture ID at the time of weigh ins. Once weigh ins begin the doors will be locked and nobody will leave or enter the weigh in area until weigh ins are complete. Any skin irregularities/diseases must be accompanied by a note from a physician stating the disease is non-communicable. Physicians must have the clearance filled out on a STATE APPROVED FORM.

## Seeding/Bracket

Brackets are imported and filled from the results of the sub regional tournaments.

## Coaches Passes

Athletic directors from each school will be asked to send a screenshot of their cleared wrestling coaches in final forms. Only coaches who are cleared in final forms will be issued a coaches pass, no exceptions.

## Spectators

There will be designated seating for spectators. No spectators are allowed on the floor or wrestling areas. Only coaches approved by your district are allowed in the corner and on the floor.

## State Qualifiers

The top $\mathbf{4}$ place finishers in each weight division for the boys will qualify for the state tournament. The top 3 place finishers in each weight division for the girls will qualify for the state tournament.

## Locker Rooms

We will utilize both the boys' and girls' locker rooms for this tournament. Athletes are responsible for their own belongings and should not leave bags or clothes unattended.

## Team Scoring

All tournament scoring will be as stated in the National Federation Rule Book.

The games committee will be decided at the seeding meeting and will consist of three (3) members:

## Media

## Bands and Noisemakers

No bands and/or noisemakers will be allowed.

## Awards

Awards will be handed out following the completion of championship matches of each weight class. Top 4 finishers will receive awards. The top 4 boys' finishers and the top 3 girls' finishers
will be photographed for the state tournament program. All placers should be in school issued gear at the time of the awards.
