Seeding: CWAC #1 vs. CWAC #5 or GSL #4

CWAC #2 vs. GSL #3 CWAC #3 vs. GSL #2 CWAC #4 vs. GSL #1

*NOTE: In the case of documented injury, the CWAC 6 and GSL 5 are

considered alternates for the pigtail matches.

Weigh-In: Will be in the Fitness/Mat Room on the main level. Athletes will be

weighed by weight class on three scales. Wrestlers must provide identification and any skin irregularities/diseases must be

accompanied by the state approved skin lesion medical release form

and signed by a physician stating the earliest date of return to

competition.

Mats: Four mats will be used through the consolation rounds. Two mats will be

used for the final Championship Round (1st & 2nd Places).

Games Committee: Head Official, WIAA representative, and/or 2 neutral

administrators/supervisors

Officials: Assigned by WOA

Floor access: <u>Limited to two school representatives and four cheerleaders for</u>

each match NO EXCEPTIONS. If a team exceeds this limit, a warning will be given, then an unsportsmanlike team penalty may be assessed, resulting in a loss of team points. Video access will be allowed on the main floor only as 1 of 2 mat personnel. During respective matches, other team video and parent video will be allowed on the north balcony/hallway

or in the south bleachers.

Warm up area: The auxiliary gym will be available for coaches and wrestlers (in uniform)

only.

Medical: Certified Athletic Trainer Zane Davies will be on site during the

tournament and will be the final authority on any medical questions or

disputes.

Blood Clean up: Paper towels, spray bottles, and red disposal cans will be available in the

central mat area. Coaches and trainers will clean wrestlers.

Ejections: Ejection for first instance of flagrant misconduct (Federation Rule). Or,

ejection for second instance of unsportsmanlike conduct (Federation Rule) of an "abusive" nature (WIAA Standard). An ejected participant is

finished for the tournament and the remainder of the season.

Filming: Film from the south bleachers or north balcony only. 1 of 2 mat-side

personnel can be a filmer. **NO FLOOR ACCESS FOR PARENTS!**Coaches, please alert parents that they will not be allowed on the main



floor for film or photography. Parents may request film access during their son's match only, on the north balcony. This request can be made at the northwest balcony door.

Awards: The top 4 place finishers in each weight division will qualify for the state

wrestling championships on February 16th and 17th. Awards will be presented concurrently in the auxiliary gym during the championship

round.

Media: Please have your media representatives (radio, TV, and newspaper)

check in with the tournament manager (Cole Kanyer) for information and

registration.

Signs: Only one official school banner or sign will be allowed in the arena.

School banners must be given to the ticket taker. Banners will be hung from the north balcony banister by the tournament manager or designee.

Team Seating Eating w Coolers:

Teams will be allowed to put their food coolers, etc in the Aux. Gym.

Tables and garbage cans will be provided in the Aux. Gym for eating

(Please clean up when you have finished eating). **NO TEAMS**,

COOLERS OR LARGE PARCELS OF FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SPECTATORS/FANS BLEACHERS (SOUTH). Wrestlers and coaches may stage in the north bleachers and portable bleachers on the

East and West side of the gym.

Hospitality Room: NO KIDS/STUDENTS/WRESTLERS/CHEERLEADERS ALLOWED!

Please remember to clean up after eating.

State Photos: Photographs of the top 4 placers will be taken in the auxiliary gym

immediately after the presentation of each weight class award. Please assist us in getting your athletes to the auxiliary gym for their photo! School warm up tops (zippered or buttoned) and bottoms are required

Admissions: All day passes \$11.00 Adults, \$8.00 Students with ASB, and Seniors

Tickets will be sold ONLINE ONLY through GoFan. There will not be a

cash option at the gate.

Passes: The Region IV Tournament pass policy will follow WIAA guidelines:

• One (1) pass per participant

• One (1) pass administrator/supervisor (no floor access)

 One (1) cheer supervisory pass (<u>no floor access</u>) issued at door when cheer team arrives



- Coaches passes:
 - o 2 passes (provided in team info packet)
 - o 3 passes (upon request by tournament manager if team has 3-9 participants)
 - o 4 passes (upon request by tournament manager if team has 10 or more participants)
 - o The WIAA fee is \$25 per coach for extra floor passes and will be assessed to each school who exceeds that limit.

Press Pass, WIAA Lifetime pass, WSSAAA Pass, and WSCA Passes accepted No school or district passes will be accepted.

Cheerleaders: A cheerleader roster signed by the school principal must be presented to

the tournament host. A cheer coach must be present. Cheerleaders must

wear uniforms to be admitted or re-admitted.

Valuables: Each team is responsible for their own valuables. Ellensburg High School

is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Towels: Each team must provide its own towels.
