## Tournament Schedule for Saturday, February 10

- 8:30 am Doors will open for teams to arrive. Locker rooms and check scales are available.
- 9:25 am All participants must be in the weigh-in area by 8:55 am. Line-up by weight class on the mats.
- 9:30 am Weigh-in will be started by *team, due to ferries and transportation*
- 10:15 am Coaches meeting.
- 9:45 am Doors open to spectators.**
- 11:00 am **Anticipated schedule (will progress without breaks).**
  - 11:00 am – 12:45 pm Round 1, championship bracket
  - 12:45 pm – 2:00 pm Championship semi-finals and Consolation 1
  - 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm Consolation semi-finals
  - 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm Third and fifth place matches
  - 4:30 pm – 5:30 pm Championship finals and awards

Weigh-In: Weigh-in will be completed by weight class. **Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.**

Mats: Three mats will be used for the first two rounds, two mats for the rest of the tournament.

Pass Gate Lists: AD's/Coaches need to submit pass gate lists via **email to** the tournament director **before 3:00pm on Thursday, February 8.**

Passes: Four coaches, two managers, and one student video, photo, and newspaper representative (school authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge, but their names must be on the pass gate list. Only WIAA authorized passes, WSCA (WA Coaches Association) passes and WSSAAA (WA athletic director association) passes will be honored. School district and league passes will NOT be accepted.

Signage: No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Buses: **After dropping off teams, move to the west side of the gym, in front of the main school.**

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Qualifiers: The top **THREE (3)** wrestlers advancing to the WIAA Mat Classic XXXV at the Tacoma Dome on February 16-17, 2024. The fourth-place finisher will be the Region 1 alternate to state.

Awards: Medals awarded to the top three placers in each weight class.  
All wrestlers will wear their school warm-ups on the podium.  
**NO HATS, HOODS, OR HEADPHONES ON THE PODIUM OR FOR WIAA STATE PROGRAM PHOTOS**

Bracketing: The bracket will be the same for each weight class and will be flipped top-to-bottom every weight, though they are the same.
