This year's Boys' Region 5 SCAC Wrestling Tournament will be held at Connell High School on Saturday, February 10th, 2024. ConnellHigh School welcomes all of the teams on their road to State. Below you will find the information for the tournament. Please be sure to review.

## **Bracket & State Berths**

This year all weight classes will have 8-man brackets that will be run through Track Wrestling. At the end of the tournament, **the top 3 (4th is an alternate) wrestlers from each weight class will earn a place in this year's Mat Classic at the Tacoma Dome.** These wrestlers will also get their picture taken to be featured in this year's State Wrestling Program. Medals will be handed out for the top 4 places.

## Awards Ceremony:

Wrestlers will be called up by weight class and place to take the podium and be given their medals at the conclusion of the tournament. Please make sure your athlete attends the award ceremony. Wrestlers will be taken immediately from the podium off to the side to have their picture taken for the Mat Classic Program. Please make sure all athletes understand this, so they don't leave the podium without getting their picture taken. For the Picture, wrestlers should be wearing their warm-up tops.

## Alternates

Special Note: Alternates must weigh in to be eligible to compete. Also, Alternates will ONLY be entered into the tournament if a wrestler from their weight class AND their own District/League are injured, sick, or do not make weight. Alternates will be placed in the lowest seeded position for their District and all other wrestlers will be bumped ahead in seeding to fill the spaces for their District.

## Seeding:

Seeding will be done based on placement by respective District/League Tournaments.

## Weigh-in Procedure:

Photo ID is <u>**REQUIRED</u>**. Weigh-in will take place in the Toppenish High School Wrestling Room/Auxiliary Gym. Wrestlers are required to report 15 minutes prior. Each coach is required to bring their WIAA weigh in sheet. **Don't be late to weigh-ins**, officials will lock the doors during weigh-in procedures, no one will be allowed to enter after this point.</u>

#### Mats:

3 mats will be used for the tournament.

## Locker Rooms:

There are locker rooms and showers available for use. Please bring your own towels if you plan on showering.

#### Team only locations:

The southwest side of the gymnasium will have a warmup mat and will be designated for athletes and coaches only. Please no parents, equipment, and supplies in this area. Only coaches and athletes currently involved in a match or on deck will be allowed on the floor. NO EXCEPTIONS

#### **Hospitality Room:**

There will be a hospitality room for <u>coaches, officials, and tournament</u> <u>workers only</u>. Please be aware of this and keep your athletes and stat keepers out of this area.

## Food:

Concessions will be available. Teams can bring their own food/coolers.

## Games Committee:

The head Tournament official and the Tournament director will develop the committee using Athletic Directors and Coaches from **neutral** schools.

## Admission:

<u>GoFan online Tickets, only no cash tickets:</u> Adult - \$11 Student/Sr. Citizen/Military - \$8 Children under 5 Free

## Pass lists:

Pass lists in a google sheet will be sent out to all schools include supervisors, administrators, and managers. Coaches will be provided wristbands in their team packet that allows them floor access and access to the hospitality room

#### Coaches

Only WIAA approved coaches are permitted to coach during the tournament. The number of coaches allowed at Regionals is based on the WIAA bound for state guidelines, and coaches need to be on the myWIAA Pass Gate List. *No more than 2 coaches are allowed on the mat during competition.* 

#### Medical:

There will <u>not</u> be a certified Athletic Trainer available. There will be an ambulance on site. Individual schools will be responsible for providing their own medical kit supplies. Ice will be available. Coaches will clean up blood on wrestlers.

#### **Floor Access:**

As a point of emphasis only 2 people are permitted to be at the corner of the mats. No one is allowed to line up along the edge of the mat. Coaches need to remain in their designated areas. Coaches, please talk with your team and let them know they need to remain in the stands. We would also like to ask that you as coaches help monitor this activity throughout the day and remind people to return to the stands.

## Ejections:

Ejection for the first instance of flagrant misconduct (Federation Rule). Or, ejection for a second instance of unsportsmanlike conduct (Federation Rule) of an "abusive" nature (WIAA Standard). <u>An ejected participant is finished for the tournament and the remainder of the season.</u>

Coaches, please talk to your athletes and fans about their language and "abusive" behavior. This will not be tolerated at any point during the tournament.

#### Venue Information:

Parking for buses and vans will be available in the south parking lots.
