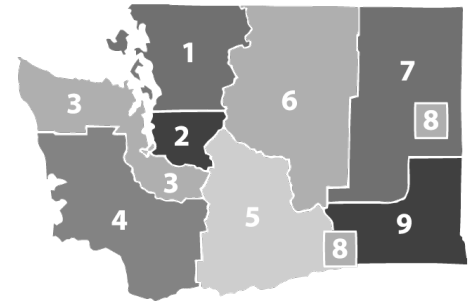

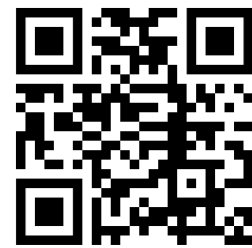

**Special Olympics Unified Sports®** is an inclusive sports program that combines an approximately equal number of Special Olympics athletes (individuals with intellectual disabilities) and partners (individuals without intellectual disabilities) on teams for training and competition.

**Season Format:** Throughout the 2024 Soccer Season (March-May), Unified Soccer teams participated in leagues from across Washington. The Unified Soccer League is designed to mimic the structure of varsity sports, with weekly league play, District Tournaments, and a State Tournament.

**State Overview:** Teams competing at the High School Unified Soccer State Tournament qualified through their District Tournament. These 8 teams will compete in bracket play in two divisions for the opportunity to be state champions!
