



What happens after your child is referred through Help Me Grow MN?

Your child's local school district will contact you to set up a meeting. The meeting will review your concerns and what kind of support you and your child might need.



If more information is needed, a free developmental evaluation may be completed. The evaluation will review your child's learning, moving, playing, and talking skills.



If your child qualifies for additional support with their development, you will work with the school's early childhood team. Together, you will write a plan for free early intervention services for your child.
