River Bend Imprints Program has an opening for a Teacher of the Emotionally and Behaviorally Disabled (EBD) to teach Science to grades 5-12. This position involves Case management of 5th and 6th grade EBD students. This position functions as a member of a highly supportive team, which includes EBD teachers, paraprofessionals, a behavior specialist, a School Social Worker, and a program coordinator.

Imprints Program is based on the Boy's Town Educational Model. All staff are provided training in Boy's Town and supported by a team of Boy's Town staff consultants.

Applicants must possess or be eligible for licensure as an EBD teacher by the MN Board of Teaching. Prior successful experience working with students with severe emotional/behavioral disabilities within a self-contained environment and teaching science is highly desirable.
