Position Title: Developmental Adapted Physical Education Teacher

Reports To: RISE Program Coordinator

Position Type: Part-Time Long-Term Substitute (daily for 2 hours)

The Part-Time DAPE Teacher provides specialized physical education instruction to students with disabilities in small group settings. This position focuses on implementing individualized education program (IEP) goals and objectives, monitoring student progress, and fostering inclusive physical activity experiences that promote motor skill development, fitness, and social-emotional growth.

During and Responsibilities

- Conducts small group and individualized instruction in adapted physical education,
- utilizing differentiated teaching strategies
- Teaches knowledge and skills in physical fitness, health education, and individual or team sports, using state standards
- Designs and implements developmentally appropriate activities that address motor, cognitive, and social-emotional needs
- Monitors and documents student progress toward IEP goals and objectives using curriculum-based measurement and observation data
- Conducts formal and informal assessments to track motor skill development and physical fitness

- Strong communication and collaboration skills
- Ability to differentiate instruction and adapt activities for diverse learners
- Demonstrate knowledge of resources, content, and pedagogy
- Experience working with students with disabilities and/or supporting social, emotional, and behavioral needs
