

# Grades 7 – 12 Wabasha-Kellogg Public Schools Chromebook Protection Plan Agreement



## \*\*\*Each student that leases a W-K owned Chromebook is responsible for his/her own device at all times\*\*\*

Annual Lease and Protection Plan Premium: \$55 per student/year; \$165 Three Year Total

#### **Scholarship Fund:**

Wabasha-Kellogg has a scholarship fund available to help pay for the Lease and Protection plan for students who qualify. If eligible, the scholarship fund pays \$40 and the student pays \$15 for the lease of the Chromebook. Contact Ann or Lisa in the High School office to determine if your child is eligible for this scholarship.

#### Coverage:

- The District issued Chromebook comes with a 3 year, 3 claim accidental damage/manufacturer warranty.
- The District's protection plan provides protection for manufacturer defect and accidental damage.
- The District has sole authority to determine any and all replacement costs and fees due to damages.
- This plan does not cover lost or stolen devices. As with a regular textbook, if the device is lost
  or stolen, it will be the responsibility of the student. The school district will obviously use all of
  its resources and energy to help the student locate their device. The student is also expected
  to have a lock on their lockers to help protect their device and other school and personal
  belongings.
- The District reserves the right at any time to require students to check in/out devices daily.
- If the device is damaged beyond repair and is considered 'totaled,' the device will be replaced under the warranty plan, but then the plan is terminated. At that point, the student/parent would be responsible for any future damages or issues.
- Damaged devices must be returned to the District before replacement can be determined.
   While waiting for their device to be repaired, the student will be able to use one of the district's Chromebooks free of charge.
- Battery chargers and cords are also issued with the device and are considered part of the
  device, but are not covered under the protection plan. If damaged, lost or stolen, the student is
  responsible to replace. The issued charger and cord must also be returned at the end of the
  school year with the device or the student will be charged appropriately.

### Wabasha-Kellogg Student & Parent Agreement For District Issued Chromebooks

- 1. I will take good care of my Chromebook.
- 2. I will never leave my Chromebook unattended.
- 3. I will never loan out my Chromebook to other individuals.
- 4. I will know where my Chromebook is at all times.
- 5. I will charge my Chromebook's battery as needed.
- 6. I will keep food and beverages away from my Chromebook since they may cause damage.
- 7. I will not disassemble any part of my Chromebook or attempt any repairs.
- 8. I will use my Chromebook in ways that are appropriate, meet W-K School District expectations and are educational.
- 9. I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the Chromebook. I will not deface the serial number sticker on my Chromebook.
- 10. I understand that my Chromebook is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of the W-K School District.
- 11. I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by my neglect or abuse.
- 12. I agree to return the Chromebook and charger/cord in good working condition.
- 13. I will inform the High School office of any theft, vandalism or damage to my Chromebook.
- 14. I will file a police report in case of theft and/or vandalism.
- 15. I will not take pictures, video and audio recordings of any student or staff member without consent.
- 16. I will not take pictures, video and audio recordings of any student or staff member at any time in locker rooms or restrooms.
- 17. I will follow the policies outlined in our district handbook, as well as all of the school policies while at school, as well as outside of the school day.

By signing this form I accept and agree to the Protection Plan and Student Parent Agreement. I also agree to the stipulations set forth in the above documents including the Chromebook Protection Plan and the Chromebook Acceptable Use Procedures and Information, as well as other district policies outlined in the Wabasha-Kellogg Secondary Student & Parent Handbook. Failure to comply with these procedures and policies may result in disciplinary consequences which may include the loss of privilege to take the Chromebook home or use the Chromebook in general.
