Motion by Jeffery, seconded by Michelle Meyer to Approve Resolution Adopting Additional Health and Safety Measures for the 2021-2022 School Year related to when a mask mandate would be required. Motion Carried.

The School District will require masks to be worn inside all School District buildings when the number of individuals (staff & students) exhibiting Influenza like Illness is equal to or greater than 37 individuals or 6% of total school population. The School District will maintain the mask requirement until the number of individuals exhibiting Influenza like Illness drops below 37 individuals or 6% of the total school population for 10 consecutive school days.

Influenza like Illness: Having one more common symptom or two less common symptoms). Following is a list of those symptoms:

More common symptoms include: Fever of 100.4 or higher, new cough or a cough that gets worse, difficulty/hard time breathing, new loss of taste or smell.

Less common symptoms include: Sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, chills, muscle pain, extreme fatigue/feeling very tired, new severe/very bad headache, new nasal congestion/stuffy or runny nose.
