

Wabasha-Kellogg Public Schools Policy

910 UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE (DRONE) POLICY

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to protect the sanctity, safety and expected privacy of the students, staff, parents and visitors of the Wabasha-Kellogg School District.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any purpose by any person on School District grounds. Additionally, it is prohibited for an entity to navigate UAV devices in the airspace above School District grounds regardless of the location of the operator.

III. DEFINITIONS

A. A UAV is any aircraft without a human pilot aboard the device.

IV. IMPLEMENTATION

- A. This prohibition applies to all fields of play, courts, arena, mats, gym floor or pool, and includes a ban on the entire facility and grounds, including the spectator areas and parking areas.
- B. School District personnel and/or tournament management shall refuse admission or entry to anyone attempting to use an UAV; and if necessary, shall remove anyone attempting to use an UAV and/or confiscate the UAV.
- C. An exception to this policy, in writing, may be made in specific cases to School District administration and/or designee. All requests need to be received at least 48 hours prior to the proposed request to use a UAV on School District property.
