Played in 5 games – Forfeit Cedarcrest game, Athletic director to put together a plan on how to prevent this from happening again. 3.TYEE – VB coach 2nd violation of using a student Manager like a coach. Suspended for 4 games and on probation until end of 2025-26 VB season 4.MTSI – Girls soccer player played too many halves in one day – Katie Deines Head coach, on probation for one calendar year, AD to work with coaching staff on an action plan to make sure this does not happen again. MTSI AD was able to show student athlete did not have an impact on the game so game was not forfeited. 5.INTL – Student not on Cleared to participate list and allowed to swim. Head coach on probation for one year, AD to review best practices for attendance. 1. Tyee – Head VB coach violation number three of using a student manager as a coach – Coach suspended for the rest of the season. Extended probation through the 2025-26 volleyball season. 2.NRCK – Head coach played a JV only player in a varsity girls soccer game. Forfeited game against LWAS on 9-24-24, coach on probation for one calendar year.
