We have already agreed on the brackets, just need to talk about how we seed into those tournaments.</p> <p>2A baseball - all are in the same division and can seed from the regular season. All 5 teams make it to SeaKing. No need for motion as all teams are in the same division.</p> <p>3A baseball - 4 and 3 in each division. Proposing a seeding committee, commissioners and 1 crest coach and 1 mountain coach. We look at this very similar to basketball. These would seed out the 7 spots.</p> <p>4A baseball - 8 in crown and 4 in crest division. Proposing a seeding committee of the commissioner, 2 crown coach and 1 crest coach as well as a lincoln rep.</p> <p>2A fastpitch - We do not think there should be a seeding committee needed. Cedarcrest has a harder division than the rest of the 2A's.
