Tennis is very unique when it comes to seeding into the post season as you do need to see the other singles and doubles from your classification. We need to re look at our schedule to see if we need to revote on the schedule.</p> <p>We all need to make sure we are going back to our coaches and discussing the schedules that we are looking at to approve.</p> <p>Schedule was motioned to be reopened.</p> <p>When looking at the feedback from fall, the seeding was beyond difficult when we didn't have the head to head match ups in classification. We created a schedule that did not take that into consideration at all. In tennis, we need some sort of schedule that has everyone seeing eachother. 3A and 2A are easier to schedule non leagues with eachother. Although with how large 4A is it is harder to schedule everyone to see eachother.</p> <p>We have a few options when it comes to scheduling - 16-8 structure would give the match ups for 4A, but does create a problem for 3A's. The coaches came up with solutions instead of going against the multi classification scheduling.</p> <p>Results of the surveys was sent out from Wes. Crown/crest and Mountain/lake combo was wanted most for mens. Crown, crest/mountain, lake was most wanted for womens but was very close with the second option. Commissioners think that the crown/crest and mountain/lake would work best for mens basketball to help the smaller teams not have to be stuck in lake. Womens schedule is where we need to discuss since the vote was very close.</p> <p>The top teams of womens basketball are a lot stronger than the bottom of the crest teams. The two schedules crown, crest/mountain, lake and crown/crest, mountain and lake are extremely tight in what the coaches want.</p> <p>Post season models - 2A 5 team bracket, 3A double elimination model to help those teams that got eliminated the first round and maybe get the 3rd or 4th seed, Cree model, 4A model kelly model - category bracket, with Lincoln playing the 12 seed, bracket with clarity shows how the seeds would go into the bracket.
