Treasurer's Report	FYI	Colleen Lowell	<p>\$118,000 is our networth at the moment for our league account. Transactions were given from June to September</p> <p>Grand total from spring playoffs was \$19,000 which is way more than we have been before. We brought in money for fastpitch this past year which we were in the negative the year before. Girls tennis we lost more money than we did the year before, although we paid more for managers this past year. Baseball was up by atleast \$5000 than the year before. Brought in less than the year before for track. The expenses for track were up from the year before, which took away a lot of our income. Boys soccer brought in around \$13,000 which is an increase from the year before. Girls golf we lost \$3400, but is down from the year before.</p> <p>Overall we are up around \$10,000 from the year before.</p> <p>Colleen will be sending the league dues invoice out sometime in the next week. We have money available to spread back out to the KingCo schools.
