

**Board Meeting Minutes
June 14, 2018**

The Board of Education of Independent School District No. 299, Caledonia, Minnesota, met in special school board meeting in Room E107 of the middle/school high school building at 1:00 p.m. to begin the interviews for the superintendent position. The school board members present were Jared Barnes, Melissa Marschall, Emily McGonigle, Kelley McGraw, Jimmy Westland arriving at 6:30 p.m., and Wendy Woyczik. Absent was Director Spencer Yohe.

SUPERINTENDENT POSITION

The school board held its interviews for the position of superintendent. The interviews were conducted as follows in Room E107 of the middle/high school building: Joel Timmerman at 1:30 p.m.; Craig Ihrke at 2:45 p.m.; Brandon Munson at 4:45 p.m.; and Steven Baule at 6:15 p.m.

After the interviews were completed, the board deliberated and selected a finalist for the superintendent position. They felt that they were fortunate to have exceptional candidates for the superintendent position and that anyone of the candidates would serve the school district well. The board recommended Brandon Munson as the candidate to fill this position and requested that the board proceed with negotiations with Mr. Munson at this time.

Moved by Emily McGonigle, seconded by Jared Barnes to offer employment to Brandon Munson as the Superintendent beginning the 2018-2019 school year contingent upon the mutually acceptable negotiated contract and the successful passage of a criminal background check. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.
