#### ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

Mrs. Meinertz informed the board that our school will be planning and holding a training for WSU student teachers and many of the staff from Caledonia. She informed the board of the staffing changes for the 2017-2018 school year. Nancy Runningen and she wrote a grant this past winter to hold an early learning cohort in June. She updated the board regarding the Early Learning Cohort grant that Nancy Runningen and she wrote this past winter and was awarded. She is working with three other principals in the state of Minnesota to

redesign a support workshop for early career principals. She updated the board regarding the Title grant and stated that they are looking to have Title focus on Math this year, while ADSIS funding will be specified for more language arts support.

Mrs. Morem was absent from the meeting. Her report that she submitted to the board stated that the boys and girls participated in the state track meet, and the boys received third place in the 4x100. The state golfers did well. Summer school has been in process the past two weeks. The band has been rehearsing for the summer events that they are participating in. Tractor safety was held. Registration for next year's high school courses continues. She attended the summer conference for secondary principals. They continue to prepare for August staff development.

Superintendent Barton stated that is great to see Mrs. Meinertz and Mrs. Morem accept the significant leadership roles that they have accepted with the Minnesota Principal's Association. He informed the board that he will not be in attendance at the July 17<sup>th</sup> board meeting. He has been busy working on the budget and the administrative evaluations. He discussed the idea of having Ehler's do a phone conference call or attend the School Board Retreat on July 11<sup>th</sup>, and it was the consensus of the board to contact them and to have them be part of this meeting if possible. The board also congratulated Mr. Barton for being accepted as part of the National School Superintendent Certification Program.

Mrs. Meyer informed the board that she has been busy working on the budget. She also continues to pursue the possibility of doing online applications for free and reduced meals as part of the NutriKids Program. She attended the Region V session and has also met with a Southeast Service Cooperative representative in regards to coop purchases for the school district.
