Content Area	Learning Focuses
<i>Number & Operations</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can identify numbers 0-31• Can count by 1's 100• Can count by 10's to 100• Can count backwards from 20• Can write numbers to 31• Uses one-to-one correspondence while counting objects to 31.• Can find a number that is one more or one less than a given number.• Compare and order numbers from 0-20• Can make and take apart numbers 0-10• Can add and subtract to 10
<i>Algebra</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify, create, and extend simple patterns using color, shape, and size
<i>Geometry & Measurement</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recognize basic two- and three-dimensional shapes such as squares, circles, triangles, rectangles, cubes, cones, cylinders, and spheres• Sort objects using characteristics such as shape, size, and color• Use words to compare objects according to length, size, and weight• Order two or three objects using measurable attributes, such as length and weight

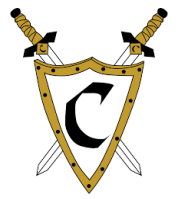
